17.	Red Yellow, Green, Rangoli Colors. Decorate the entrance of your house with an attractive Rangoli Design. You can also use colored chalks or crayons. 	1 small bowl each (Optional)
18.	Rangoli (fine powder of white stone, used to create decorative designs in front of the door of the house)	5-6 Oz
19.	Iron Nails 3" long with square/round head	5-6
20.	Kalash with Lid (earthen pot approx 6"-8" tall). If you can not get ordinary plain red you can get decorative ceramic pot with lid 	1 with Lid (MUST)

30.	Panch Dhatu (Small pieces of five metals – e.g. Gold, Silver, Copper, Brass, Steel, Iron etc to be put in the earthen pot with the Vastu Pratima. Small nails, pieces of wires, drawing pins, small balls/bids, cut pieces etc... can be used).	1 set
